Student Advisory Board Member Applicant Disclaimers

- To be an eligible applicant, prospective student advisory board members must be in high school (**grade/form 10 through grade/form 12**) for the entirety of the Diamond Challenge 2019 season from May 2018 through April 2019
- To be an eligible applicant, prospective student advisory board members must have 24 hour, seven day a week access to the Internet
- Prospective student advisory board members are required to have participated in the Diamond Challenge prior to applying for the position
- If you are selected as a Diamond Challenge student advisory board member, you are **not** eligible to compete in the Diamond Challenge 2019 so as to avoid any conflicts of interest
- The Diamond Challenge team serves as the arbiter of all Diamond Challenge student advisory board rules. The Diamond Challenge team owns the right to ask a student advisory board member to step down from their leadership position at any time
