

Companion Enrollment

By participating in an EntreX, DesignX, or LeadX class at school, your student has an exclusive opportunity to enroll in a University of Delaware companion course and earn official college credit. Below are answers to common questions and details on how to take advantage of this opportunity.

Why Enroll?

Earning college credit in high school builds academic confidence, demonstrates college readiness, and may provide students with more flexibility in future course selection or even accelerate time to graduation. Students will receive a University of Delaware transcript, and while transfer policies vary, credits often transfer successfully. With discounted tuition rates, this opportunity also offers significant financial savings.

What are the Course Options and Costs?

Students may choose to enroll in the following courses based on their in-school experience:

- **EntreX | ENTR102: Entrepreneurship Experience II**
3 credits - Tuition: \$500
Explore entrepreneurial mindsets and develop real-world problem-solving skills.
- **DesignX | ENTR367: Creativity & Sustainable Design Experience II**
3 credits - Tuition: \$500
Learn the design thinking process while tackling sustainability challenges.
- **LeadX | ENTR154: Leadership Experience II**
1 credit - Tuition: \$190
Build essential leadership skills and habits for personal and collective growth.

Need-based scholarships are available and can be requested for any course during the registration process.

Will the Credit Transfer?

While transfer policies vary by institution, students will receive official University of Delaware credit, and past students have successfully transferred these credits to institutions such as: American University, Boston University, Bucknell University, Indiana University, Lehigh University, Penn State University, Muhlenberg College, Saint Joseph's University, Tennessee University, University of Pittsburgh, and University of Wisconsin. We recommend checking the credit transfer policy of your student's intended college or university to confirm.



How to Register?

Students are strongly encouraged to complete registration by **November 1** to ensure timely access to the course and its requirements. The final deadline to complete any outstanding enrollment steps is January 26, 2026.



Complete all three steps through the Companion Enrollment Portal at hornentr.com/entrexcompanion or scan the QR code.

1. **Create a University of Delaware ID (UDID)** – This grants access to the university system.
2. **Upload the completed registration form** – This reserves your student's course placement.
3. **Submit payment** – Tuition must be paid in full to finalize enrollment.

All three steps must be completed for enrollment to be confirmed.
