What is Diamond Challenge?

Diamond Challenge is an opportunity for teens from around the world to learn entrepreneurship, engage with a like-minded community and compete for \$100,000 in awards. Created by Horn Entrepreneurship at the University of Delaware, Diamond Challenge is recognized as a top-rated entrepreneurship competition through which high school students participate by developing ideas to address pressing challenges they've identified.

How does Diamond Challenge Work?

Diamond Challenge operates on a 9-month cycle and is open to any high school student around the world. With access to free curriculum resources and our online global community, teams develop a business or social venture concept for submission in early January. All concepts are evaluated by a diverse group of volunteer judges and receive meaningful feedback. As teams advance, many will participate in live pitch sites based on their region or record a pitch to be judged virtually. Finalists are chosen and invited to the culminating Diamond Challenge Summit in April.

What is the Diamond Challenge Summit?

Hosted at the University of Delaware, Diamond Challenge Summit is a unique three-day conference providing students, educators, and supporters from around the world the opportunity to develop new skills while energizing their entrepreneurial spirit. Attendees learn from world-class speakers, entrepreneurs, mentors and forge lifelong connections. Finalists participate in live pitch rounds to compete for various awards and cash prizes.
