



The Summit Committee Position Description

To be eligible to serve on this Committee, you must have attended the Diamond Challenge Summit in the past and commit to attending the Diamond Challenge Summit 2019, which will be hosted on April 10-12, 2019.

As a member of the Summit Committee, the Committee is charged with developing and enhancing the Summit experience for student advisory board members, competitors and other fellow Summit attendees. Committee responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Identifying prospective speakers, workshop hosts, panelists, pop-up competition facilitators, mentors, etc. for the Summit in collaboration with the Diamond Challenge Program Coordinator
- Creating an interactive Diamond Challenge board that will be displayed at the Summit next to the Diamond Challenge table
- Engaging with attendees, discussing the student advisory board program opportunity, and manning the Diamond Challenge table
- Cultivating at least two to three student advisory board-led activities or workshops that will be executed at the Summit
- Coordinating the Summit welcome dinner team-building activities in collaboration with the Diamond Challenge Program Coordinator
- Planning the Summit student advisory board dinner and feedback session in collaboration with the Diamond Challenge Program Coordinator
